

03 What To Expect



Program Goals

Students will be trained for the purpose of preparing for entry-level positions that are normally available in a variety of dental facilities.

Program Length

The program is 12 weeks long and includes a 40-hour externship to equip students with the necessarily skills and knowledge to excel as dental assistants.

Program Format

The class format includes online learning modules throughout the week to prepare students for in-person labs in a real dental office. Online learning modules feature a mix of interactive videos, activities, video lab demonstrations, and more to prepare students for their in-person labs. Students can expect to spend approximately 4.5 hours engaging in hands-on labs each week for the duration of the program.

Program Topics

During the course of the program, students will learn everything they need to know to become successful dental assistants, including how to:

- Properly Use Personal Protective Equipment
- Prepare and Breakdown the **Dental Operatory**
- Follow Dental Office Sanitization and Sterilization Protocols
- Identify Dental Instruments and Accessories, and Their Uses
- Identify Dental Anatomy Components
- Perform Chairside Duties, Including Instrument Transfer and Moisture Control

- Fabricate Temporary Crowns and Bleach Trays
- Digitally Chart Existing and Planned Treatment
- Capture Clinically Acceptable Radiographs Included in a Full Mouth Series of X-Rays
- Capture Clinically Acceptable Alginate Impressions
- Pour and Trim Diagnostic Models

Externship Details

There is a 40-hour required externship portion of the course to help students reinforce their hands-on learning. In addition to this minimum requirement, students may choose to complete more than 40 hours, as these hours can improve their hands-on skills and look great on their resumes.

Program Outcome + Certificate Awarded

Once all requirements have been met, students will receive a Certificate of Completion and will leave the program with the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to begin a successful career as dental assistants

Admissions Requirements

The requirements for admission are as follows:


- Minimum Age: Must be at least 17 years of age (applicants under the age of 18 require written permission from a parent or legal guardian in order to enroll).
- Education: Must present proof of secondary education (high school diploma or transcript, or high school equivalency). *The state of North Carolina requires a transcript as proof.
- **Identification:** Furnish a valid driver's license, state ID, or passport.
- Immunization: Provide a copy of your shot records (or sign a Vaccination Declination Waiver) to include:
 - Hepatitis B
 - Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (TDP)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- Varicella


